



Terminus


Indicates the start and end of a flow or sub-flow. At the start it should identify the flow or sub-flow name. Sub-flows often end with a Flow Reference (see below) to return to the calling flow.



Page

Description

A single page in the site or application.




Multi-Page

Description

A set of pages in the site or application, typically a series of content pages that share the same layout or template and that are accessed from an index page.

Comment
Or Flow
Reference


A comment on the flow, content, actions, or processes.
A reference to another flow or sub-flow necessary to complete a process.

User
Action

Indicates that the user performs an action (with the mouse or a keyboard shortcut), such as checks an option, selects a tab, selects a link, or presses a button.


User
Decision

The user must make a decision or choice to continue the process; these are most often binary choices (e.g., OK/Cancel, Save/Cancel, Next/Previous, Yes/No, etc.) and a user action is implied (i.e., to select "Next" implies pressing a button or selecting a link.)




User Input

The user enters data (usually with the keyboard) in available form fields; they may also select data or ranges of data from presented lists. The user either enters data or selects from data.

System
Decision

The system (site, application, or tool) must evaluate data or a condition before continuing the process.


System
Action

The system performs an action to generate, update, or modify the information, data, or form fields displayed on a page, such as displaying an error message and highlighting the incorrect field or updating data based on user action or input.



Database

The system saves, modifies, deletes, or retrieves data from a server-side database.

Download
Document

A downloadable document or streaming media file is made available to the user.
